United Way – Blackhawk Region Awards Community Grant to HealthNet

JANESVILLE, WI – HealthNet of Rock County was notified in late-December that United Way – Blackhawk Region would be awarding \$96,360 for the 2018-2019 grant cycle. This investment will go towards HealthNet of Rock County’s medical, dental, and vision programs, and will be the first time that an 18-month investment has been made to the organization.
